EXTENSION (IV) OF THE LETTER OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN WFP AND YRC for the period 1^{st} - 30 September 2001

The Letter of Understanding signed between WFP and YRC on 13-10-2000 covering the year 2000 expired on 31 December 2000. Its first extension covering the period January - June 2001 expired on 30 June 2001 and its second and third extensions covering July and August 2001 expired on August 31st 2001.

This is to confirm that the co-operation between WFP and YRC will continue under the same Letter of Understanding during the month of September 2001 under the same terms and conditions indicated in the basic Letter of Understanding signed on 13-10-2000 and in its first/second/third extensions covering the period January-August 2001. However, due to the changed working environment and following mutual agreement reached between WFP and UNHCR, the following change to the previous working arrangements will come into effect after the completion of September 2001 distribution to refugees:

• In line with the WFP letter no. 940 of 05 September 2001 (copy attached herewith for easy reference), WFP will recover all WFP food commodities remaining after the completion of the September 2001 food distribution from the YRC regional warehouses in Belgrade, Sabac and Pozarevac. Food quantities needed for future WFP food distributions to refugees in private accommodations in these three areas (from October 2001 onwards) will be supplied from a WFP managed warehouse in Belgrade.
